NMAP 2009/1	<p>Maniben Sita Collection</p> <p>Sita's 1963 diary, with additional entries from 1962. Also includes leaflets: "The Group Areas Act &amp; Mr. Nana Sita" (1964?), SA Indian Congress, London; and pamphlets: "I Accuse!" Speeches to court by Nelson Mandela, 1962-1963 trial (origin unknown); "South Africa's Treason Trial" (1957), "Afrika!" Publications, Johannesburg.</p> <p>1957-1964</p>

NMAP 2009/13	<p>Himie Bernadt Collection</p> <p>Files of the legal firm Frank, Bernadt &amp; Joffe concerning certain legal matters pertaining to its client, Nelson Mandela, between 1966 and 1990. These papers detail examples of his endeavours to secure rights for prisoners through challenging the legality of acts carried out by prison officers, his opposing of the state's attempt to have him struck off the role of attorneys, family-related matters, etc.</p> <p>1966 to 1990</p>
NMAP 2009/14	<p>Sahm Venter Collection</p> <p>13 boxes of documents accumulated by Sahm Venter from ca. 1984-2002 as part of her work as a journalist as well as a dedicated political activist during the struggle for liberation in South Africa. NMAP 2009/29	<p>Motsamayi Mpho Collection</p> <p>1 box of textual materials, mainly of copies of material from the collection of Motsamayi Mpho and his participation in the struggle for liberation in South Africa. The collection has been loosely categorised into correspondence, newsclippings, publications, personal papers, pamphlets/leaflets/flyers, calendars, 1956 Women's Anti Pass Campaign. The collection includes rare 1950s and early 1960s newspaper clippings; among the clippings there is a photo of Nelson Mandela in Tunisia and Ethiopia.</p> <p>ca. 1956 - 1995</p>

NMAP 2009/90	<p>Rica Hodgson Collection</p> <p>2 boxes Manuscripts and transcripts of interviews of Rica Hodgson in the making of her autobiography, Foot Soldier for Freedom. NMAP 2010/6	<p>The Times – Late War Edition of 18 July 1918</p> <p>Copy of the newspaper "The Times", London. Issue of the day of Mandela's birth. Full of news about World War I.</p> <p>1918-07-18</p>
NMAP 2010/7	<p>Warrants of Committal - Nelson Mandela</p> <p>2 Warrants of Committal issued to Nelson Mandela by the Magistrate's Court of South Africa and the Supreme Court of South Africa. Both warrants contain Nelson Mandela's fingerprints.</p> <p>1962-11-7 - 1964-6-12</p>
NMAP 2010/9	<p>Judge Thumba Pillay Collection</p> <p>7 files contained in 2 archival boxes. Two letters smuggled out of Robben Island in 1977. Mac Maharaj gave them to Judge Thumba Pillay of legal firm of Pillay Seedat &amp; Co. The letters are written by Nelson Mandela and Ahmed Kathrada, both of them wishing to appoint the firm to act on their behalf in legal proceedings against the Department of Prisons. Since the authorities refused contact with their attorneys, they had to use this "illegal" method to seek legal representation. The collection includes an envelope that Judge Pillay had posted addressed to his law firm. He did this in the event that the Security Police questioned him about how he received the letters, he would be able to prove that they were posted anonymously to him.</p> <p>A second donation of Judge Thumba Pillay contains correspondence and documents (mainly copies) pertaining to the case of Mandela vs Minister of Prisons.</p> <p>1959 - 1978</p>

Includes list of attendees at a June 1986 meeting of representatives of the business community with Oliver Tambo and the ANC; minutes and records of the bilateral talks, December 1987-July 1990; photographs of participants in the talks, 1990; June 2001 article from “Sunday Business” on Michael Young and the secret Mells Park talks. NMAP 2012/32	<p>Jack Swart Collection</p> <p>Digital images: 628 TIFF (73.3 GB) and 628 JPEG images; 1 video clip 9.09 min.</p> <p>Jack Swart was Mr Mandela's personal warder from 7 Dec 1988 to 11 Dec 1990 at Victor Verster Prison. This digitised collection includes notes by Mandela to Swart, correspondence, photographs, recipes and menus of the food Swart cooked for Mandela, and a manuscript of Swart's life story in Afrikaans. It includes a video clip of the drive from the Victor Verster House to the prison gates that Mandela would have taken on 11 Feb 1990 when he was released.</p> <p>1988-2012</p>
NMAP 2012/57	<p>Jacques Moreillon Collection</p> <p>The collection consists of a report of 3 visits by Dr Jacques Moreillon as ICRC Delegate General for Africa to Robben Island (1973, 1974 and 1975) and his meetings with Nelson Mandela during and after his incarceration. It also includes a manuscript, "Moments with Madiba"; a letter to Mandela dated 25 April 2005; and a brief resume of Moreillon, dated 2009. The report and manuscript cover the period 1963-2004, focusing on 1973 onwards.</p> <p>Dr Moreillon was part of the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) delegation that visited Robben Island from 1963 to 1986.</p> <p>ca. 2004-2009</p>
NMAP 2012/68	<p>Anti-Apartheid Movements, The Netherlands</p> <p>Printed materials, digital and printed photos, memorabilia: Mandela- and ANC-related materials from the former Anti-Apartheid Movements in the Netherlands. Included is a large collection of digital photos from the Solomon Mahlangu Freedom College (ANC) in Tanzania, as well as some other 'ANC in exile' photos, documents, t-shirts, and other memorabilia.
